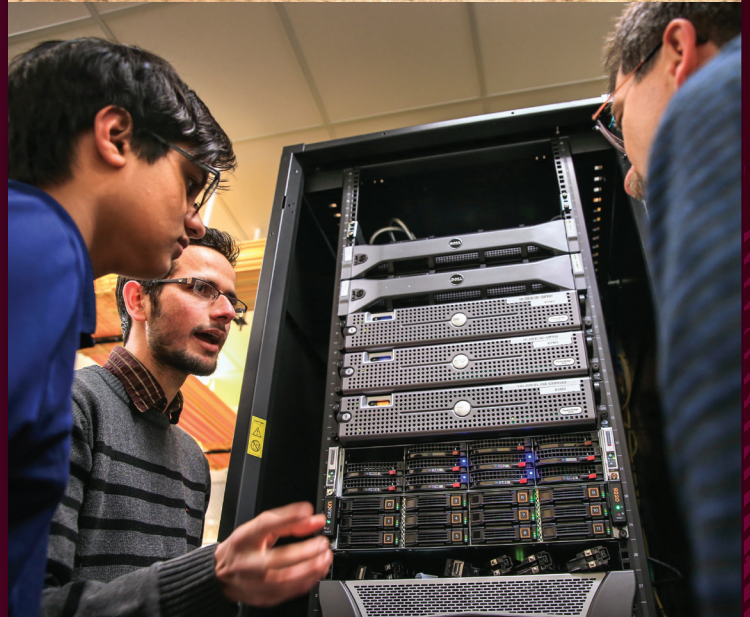

UNDECIDED ABOUT YOUR MAJOR?

More than one in four incoming freshmen aren't sure what they want to study. Some students know exactly what they want, while others discover new interests or make a decision during their freshman or sophomore year. From orientation to career advisors and through introductory courses, internships and academic student organizations, we give you the experiences, tools and resources to choose a career path you'll love.

ACADEMIC ADVISORS

We'll connect you with an academic advisor as soon as you become a Chippewa. Your advisor will support you every step of the way as you explore academic majors and career options.

ACADEMIC ORIENTATION

As a new student, you'll participate in an orientation program where you'll learn about different areas of interest. You'll attend at least one information session about an area of study.

CAREER COACHES

Meet one-on-one with a Career Services coach who can help you define and refine your career goals and obtain the skills and experiences employers value.

CED 101 AND OTHER INTRODUCTORY COURSES

Sign up for a one-credit Career and Self-Exploration course (CED 101) and choose from introductory classes in nearly every major to help you decide if an academic program fits your interests.

DEGREE PROGRESS

This online tool will make it easy for you to stay on track for graduation. It keeps track of all the course requirements you need to graduate, checking them off as they're completed.

Students log into Degree Progress through CentralLink. You'll see your general education requirements. But as you progress, selecting majors, minors and degrees, the online tool adds your required courses and shows what classes you've taken and what requirements you still need to fulfill.

STUDENT SUCCESS CENTERS

Each of our 22 residence halls gives you access to a student success center so you can meet with academic advisors, success coaches and counselors right in the building where you live. This means it's easy to get the support you need.
